- 75,000 som for citizens of the Kyrgyz Republic;
- 100,020 som for citizens of countries that are parties to the Eurasian Economic Union agreements (Russia, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan, Belarus);
- 120,000 som for citizens of countries not part of the Eurasian Economic Union (Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan, etc.);
- 150,000 som for citizens of countries outside the Eurasian Economic Union.

The Doctoral Program at the Kyrgyz State Technical University named after I. Razzakov (KSTU)

The Kyrgyz State Technical University named after I. Razzakov is the flagship of technical education in Kyrgyzstan, enjoying a special status and preparing highly qualified scientific and pedagogical personnel. In order to integrate into the global scientific community and ensure recognition of academic degrees, the university successfully implements scientific and educational programs for the preparation of Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) candidates. Citizens of the Kyrgyz Republic as well as citizens from neighboring and distant countries (China, Germany, Kazakhstan) are enrolled in the program. Supervision is provided by both domestic and foreign supervisors, including doctors and candidates of sciences, as well as PhD holders from Russia, Kazakhstan, Slovakia, Turkey, Hungary, and Germany.

Citizens of the Kyrgyz Republic and foreign nationals holding a Master's degree or Specialist qualification, as well as candidates of sciences, have the right to apply for admission to the doctoral program (PhD/profile). Instruction is conducted in full-time format with the use of distance learning technologies, both on a grant-funded and contractual basis. During the course of study, a mandatory requirement is the completion of an international internship.

The duration of the program is 3-4 years depending on the chosen field of study. The application period for the PhD doctoral program is from July 25 to September 20, 2024. Entrance examinations will be held from September 23 to September 27, with enrollment completed by October 4, 2024.
